### **Objective of the Event:**

The objective of this competition was to encourage intellectual development and healthy competition among college students. The event aimed to test participants' general knowledge, quick thinking, and ability to work under pressure.

### **Participants:**

The event was open to students from Inter-colleges across the region. A total of **34 Students** participated. Computer Science fields of study, including BCA-I & II, BCS-I & II, and Bsc(IT)- I & II Year Students are participated.

### **Event Format:**

The quiz competition consisted of **three rounds**:

#### **1. Basic Level:**

The first round included a 20-minute Basic Level Round. A set of 20 Basic C language questions and each questions carries 2 Mark and every wrong answer get minus half Mark were asked, and the top 18 students moved to the next round based on their scores.

#### **2. Medium Level:**

The second round included a 15-minute Medium Level Round. A set of 15 mix of questions ranging from C, C++ and basic shortcut keys. Each questions carries 2 Marks. the top 9 students moved to the next round based on their scores.

#### **3. Hard Questions and Find the Error's:**

The final round included a 15-minute Find the Error's round, where students were given 10 questions, and they had to answer as quickly as possible. Each question carries 5 Marks and every rong answer get 2 minus Marks. Each correct answer was awarded points, and the student with the highest score at the end of this round won the competition.

After completion of third round answer sheet of participant checked by committee member's and declare result of competition.
