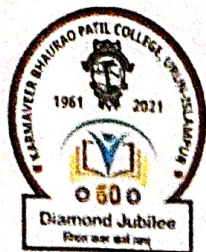

4. Encouraging Voter Turnout



5. Information on Voting Systems



6. Digital and Social Media Campaigns

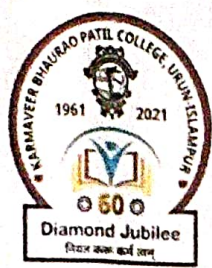
