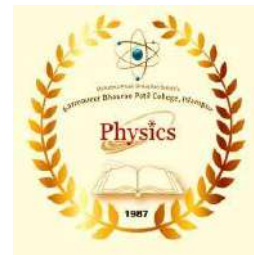

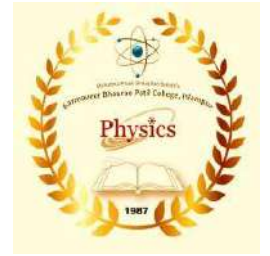

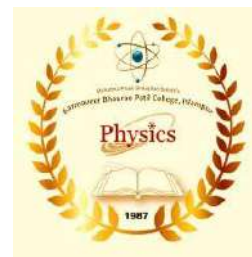

Activity Title: B.Sc. I - Induction Programme 2025

Target Audience: B.Sc. - I Students

❖ **Objective of the Activity:**

The Faculty of Science at Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil College, Urun-Islampur, successfully conducted a four-day B.Sc. I – Induction Programme from 2nd July to 5th July 2025. The programme was aimed at orienting newly admitted first-year B.Sc. students to the academic environment, co-curricular facilities, support services, and institutional culture. With the theme “4 Days of Discovery, Learning, and Inspiration!”, each day focused on a distinct area crucial for student development. Sessions were coordinated by various departments and delivered by subject matter experts and faculty members, providing the students with a well-rounded introduction to their college journey.

❖ **Summary of the Activity:**

🚩 **Day 1: 2nd July 2025 (Wednesday)**

Theme: Library Orientation & NSS Introduction

Host Department: Chemistry

This session introduced students to the Library and NSS (National Service Scheme) facilities:

- **Library Orientation:** Mr. Abhaykumar Patil gave a guided explanation of the library’s physical layout, rules, catalog system, and borrowing procedures. He also demonstrated how to access digital resources and e-journals, essential for academic research.
- **NSS Awareness:** Dr. Athavale discussed the objectives of the NSS, highlighting the importance of community service, leadership, and social responsibility. He explained how students can volunteer, the process of joining NSS, and the long-term benefits in terms of personality development and career impact.

🚩 **Day 2: 3rd July 2025 (Thursday)**

Theme: Sports, Cultural Activities & NCC Orientation

Host Department: Physics

This session covered co-curricular and extracurricular engagement opportunities at the college.

- **Sports and Fitness Activities:** Dr. A. U. Mane gave an overview of the gymkhana facilities, available sports infrastructure, and intercollegiate participation. Emphasis was placed on maintaining physical health and team-building through sports.
- **Cultural Committee Briefing:** Dr. T. T. Jagtap encouraged students to explore their talents through cultural platforms like music, drama, dance, elocution, and literary events. He also explained the annual cultural calendar and college festivals.
- **NCC Orientation:** Dr. B. A. Sawant introduced the National Cadet Corps (NCC), explaining the enrollment process, drills, discipline, and patriotic values instilled through NCC training. He highlighted how participation in NCC can enhance career opportunities, especially in defense and civil services.

The session concluded with live demonstrations and interactive Q&A, fostering student enthusiasm.

Day 3: 4th July 2025 (Friday)

Theme: Financial Support – Earn and Learn & Scholarships

Host Departments: Geography, Mathematics, Computer Science

This session focused on financial assistance and support systems available to students.

- **Earn and Learn Scheme:** Dr. S. K. Mane explained how students from economically weaker backgrounds can work part-time in the college and earn while continuing their studies. He detailed eligibility criteria, types of work offered, and how this initiative supports self-reliance.
- **Karmaveer Kalyan Nidhi:** A unique aid scheme offering financial and academic support to underprivileged students was presented.
- **Scholarship Guidance:** Mr. Vikram Salunkhe guided students through the process of applying for various government and private scholarships, including eligibility, documentation, and deadlines. He stressed the importance of availing these opportunities for uninterrupted education.

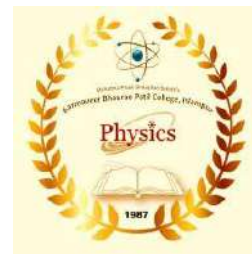
Day 4: 5th July 2025 (Saturday)

- ✚ By interacting with faculty, resource persons, and peers, students began building a sense of community and belonging.
- ✚ The sessions helped reduce anxiety and created a positive outlook toward college life.
- ✚ NSS and Karmaveer Kalyan Nidhi sessions instilled values of social service and community engagement.

Students found the programme informative and well-organized. They expressed interest in participating in NSS, NCC, or cultural activities. 







